The RES Tungkillo team would like to thank the Tungkillo community and surrounds for their interest and engagement at our early design stage of the Tungkillo Battery Energy Storage System Project (the Project).

Following the lodgement of the project's Planning Application (the application) to the State Planning Commission in October 2022, the assessment of the Project has progressed.

Through the formal assessment of the project, the State Planning Commission will refer the application to the local council and all relevant state agencies to request comments on the application.

The State Planning Commission will then place the application on public notification where members of the public are invited to make a written representation on the project during the consultation period. The consultation period will be open for a minimum of 15 business days.

The RES Tungkillo team invite the community to voice your support, ask questions, or raise concerns regarding the project during the consultation period.

A copy of our full Planning Application will be exhibited publicly during the formal consultation period of the SA Government Planning Portal on the website: https://plan.sa.gov.au/have_your_say/notified_developments/state_developments

RES is targeting for planning approval to be granted by the Minister in September 2023. Commencement of construction is on target for some time in 2025.

ASSESSMENT PROCESS

LODGEMENT OF CROWN SPONSORSHIP APPLICATION

- Application lodged to the State Planning Commission.
OCT 2023

COUNCIL AND AGENCY REFERRALS

- The local council and relevant state agencies will be given notice of the application and invited to provide comment on the application (4-6 weeks).

JUN 2023

PUBLIC NOTIFICATION

- Minimum 15 business days.
- Members of the public are invited to make a written representation during the notification period.

JULY 2023

ASSESSMENT

- After all referrals and notification steps are completed a Planning Assessment Report is prepared for the consideration of the State Commission Assessment Panel (SCAP).
- The SCAP provides advice to the Minister for Planning on the proposal.

AUG 2023

SCAP HEARING

- Where a representor wishes to be heard by the Panel or where significant planning issues or concerns are raised by a council or referral body, SCAP will convene to consider the application and provide advice to the Minister.

TBD

MINISTER FOR PLANNING FOR DECISION

- The Minister for Planning is the decision maker for all Crown development application.
- The Minister may approve all or part of a development and impose conditions or refuse the proposal. There is no appeal right against the Minister's decision.
